THE FAMILY PROGRAMS

General Counseling

Our programs provide individual, couple, family & group counseling in numerous areas including: addictions, trauma, abuse, parenting, depression, domestic violence and divorce adjustment.

Hate Crimes Project

Assists with education and prevention of Hate Crimes in our area and in the US. Provides a hotline for the community at 202-2131.

Children's Mental Health

Provides free counseling to children ages 6-18 living in Orleans, St. Bernard and Plaquemine parishes that experienced the trauma of Hurricane Katrina and its aftermath and are still showing signs or have begun to show signs of distress. To reach children, therapy groups and individual sessions are offered at schools in these parishes as well as services provided in our office.

Domestic Violence

Psychoeducational program that confronts the core issues involved in domestic violence.

New Orleans Truancy Assessment & Service Center (NOTASC)

Home, school and community based program staffed by social workers, case workers and parent support workers. Students are referred at the 5th unexcused absence; encourages voluntary participation by parents and children to prevent involvement with the Judicial System.

Family Preservation

An intensive short-term, in home crisis prevention program which strives to strengthen and support families in order to prevent out-of-home placement of children. An array of services are provided to meet the needs of families in crisis with children that are in immediate or high-risk placement outside the home.

Victims of Crime (VOCA)

Individual counseling and support groups for victims of crime. Services are provided at no cost to clients.

Active Parenting

For all parents with children up to the age of 18. An educational group that helps with issues of parenting concerns.

Child-Adolescent Response team (CART)

The Child and Adolescent Response team provides community-based, crisis care intervention to children and adolescents ages 17 and under. CART serves Orleans, St. Bernard and Plaquemines parishes. Please call the crisis line at 1-800-248-1152; services are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Diversion Program

Provides individual or group psycho-education for clients referred by the courts to teach new decision making skills

Custody Evaluation

Helps parents and the courts make custody decisions for children.

Rivarde Detention Center

Provides counseling and assessment for juveniles.
